Education loan at higher level to be introduced

Education Minister Mahbubur Rahman said the present allocation in the education sector would not be decreased in the future, reports BSS.

He said the increasing expenditure and allocation in the education sector every year proves that the government gives much attention to improving the standard of education and developing human resources of the country.

The Minister was talking to the representatives of government and non-government college teachers association and school teachers association at the Secretariate on Wednesday.

The Minister said the Government was contemplating to create a benevolent fund for the teachers of non-government institutions and introduce education loan at higher level of education for poor meritorious students.

The Education Minister said both Bangla and English would continue to play their due role at various levels of education and both the languages would be used according to their application and utility.
