

### Govt to recast exam system : Mahbub

CHANDPUR, April 22: Education Minister Mahbubur Rahman today called upon the people, particularly the teachers, students and guardians to rise unitedly against the tendency of adopting unfair means by a section of examinees, reports BSS.

The Education Minister was speaking as the chief guest at a reception organised by Chandpur Government Girls College here.

He said the examination centres which had been turned into "copying centre and dens of malpractices would be closed down".

ed out that 11 examination centres at higher secondary level had so far been cancelled and said remote examination centres would be withdrawn in order to maintain effective law and order.

The Education Minister said government was actively considering to recast the examination system with a view to curbing malpractices. The report submitted by the Examination Committee headed by Prof Shamsul Huq is awaiting adoption and implementation, he added.
