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Objective questions in '92 SSC exams likely

Education Minister Anisul Islam Mahmud said on Saturday, the Government was trying to introduce objective type questions in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination from 1992 to stop copying in examination, reports BSS.

He added that objective type questions would be set up in the examination of Class VIII.

The Minister was inaugurating the first foundation training course of officers belonging to BCS education cadre at NIEAR auditorium in Dhaka.

Presided over by Mr Hedayet Ahmed, Secretary, Ministry of Education, the inaugural function was addressed, among others, by Director-General of NIEAR and Secondary and Higher Education Directorate and Additional Secretary of the Ministry of Establishment.

Fifty members of BCS General and Technical Education cadres are participating in this two-month-long Foundation Training Course.

Education Minister said the Government was trying to bring about a qualitative change in educational sector rather than unplanned expansion of educational institutions through irrational nationalisation.

He added that the Degree colleges should not be allowed to be influenced by the frequent unrest, indiscipline and session jams which are now prevailing at the university campuses.

Education Minister said the Government was spending a sum of about Taka 1150 crore every year in education sector to run 52,000 institutions and their administrations. He stressed the need for proper training for the members of education cadre to establish an up-to-date educational administration, financing and management as well as quality teaching among the members of this cadre.
