

JnU students to continue demo for dormitories

The agitated students of Jagannath University yesterday for the second time called for a class boycott on Sunday to press home their demand for the construction of dormitories on the land of Dhaka's old central jail.

They also announced to march towards Prime Minister's Office on Monday if they do not get any positive response from the authorities concerned by Sunday.

In the morning, the students started demonstration on the campus, boycotting classes and locking the campus entrances.

They gathered there around 7:30am and tried to bar students, teachers and administrative staff from entering the campus.

Later they staged a demonstration setting fire to several tyres on the road in front of the university.
