

Standard of pvt edn institutions to be improved

Education and Cultural Affairs Minister Prof AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury Saturday said the present government aimed at developing the non-government educational institutions through ensuring local community participation, reports BSS.

The Education Minister said unplanned nationalisation of educational institutions during the autocratic government has created problems in the education system. He observed that after nationalisation the teachers become government officials and wanted to be transferred to urban areas and the local managing committees abolished and thus the institutions suffered and the standard of education deteriorated. He said the present government wanted to revitalise the educational institutions and it will follow a strict principle in this regard.

Prof Chowdhury said the standard of education of any institution depends mainly on teachers, students, parents and managing committees.
