

Students must be well-educated, says Nurul Huda

MATLAB (Chandpur), Sept. 2:—
State Minister for Information
Muhammad Nurul Huda said here
today the students must be well
educated and good citizens since the
future responsibility of running the
affairs of the state would fall on

He was addressing a students' rally
organised by Jatiyatabadi Chhatra
Dal of Matlab Thana Unit at the
