### Faridpur Polytechnic Institute closed, 57 students held

FARIDPUR, Nov 10: Police last night arrested 57 students of Local Polytechnic Institute after they resorted to unruly activities within the campus leading to the damage of government properties, reports BSS.

According to Police source, students of the Institute became furious following publication of diploma examination results in which none came out successful. The pitiable results was due to general depletion of certain percentage of marks as penalty for alleged adoption of unfair means in the examination conducted by Technical Education Board.

The students during day time got enraged after getting the news and they burnt and ransacked the office of the Principal. The police brought the situation under control and the authorities closed the institute sine die and students were asked to vacate the hostel by today.

The police was posted in the campus to check recurrence of trouble, only to find in the night that students began agitation and started destruction of properties. Finding no alternative, police took them in custody.
