

Reopening of Ctg BIT demanded

Chittagong BIT Unit of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on Monday demanded immediate reopening of Bangladesh Institute of Technology, Chittagong, reports BSS.

In a Press conference, held Monday evening at the National Press Club the leaders of BIT Unit of JCD urged the concerned authorities to check terrorism and ensure law and order in the campus.

They also demanded arrest and trial of those responsible for the incident that took place in the BIT campus on October 23 for which the Institute was closed for indefinite period from that day.

They protested Monday's half-day strike call by a student organisation at Chittagong Metropolitan City Area, saying this would strengthen the hands of terrorists.
