Missing schoolboy, bike rider found dead

Two missing people have been found dead in Mymensingh and Sherpur districts.

Police recovered the body of a minor schoolboy from a jute field at Dhanikhola village in Trishal upazila of Mymensingh on Friday, two days after his missing.

The deceased is Md Sajeeb, 8, son of Shafiqul Islam of Dhanikhola village, and a Class 1 student of Dhanikhola Governemnt Primary School. He went missing on April 3.

Locals found the body in the area and informed the police in the afternoon, said Md Moniruzzaman, officer-in-

charge of Trishal Police Station.

The law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

The boy might have been strangled following a family feud, said the OC.

A case was filed in this connection.

In Sherpur, the law enforcers recovered the body of a motorcyclist, who went missing on April 13, from a jute field in Bandherkura, Shashan area under Nalitabari upazila of the district the same day.

They also arrested four people -- Hafizul Islam, 18, Ashraful Haque, 20, Mukul Miah, 24, and Jahidul Islam,

25, of Bishgiripara village of Ramchandrakura union in Nalitabari, -- in connection with the incident.

The victim is Rokon Miah, 23, son of Fazlul Haque of Telikhali village in Haluaghat upazila.

Rokon, who used to carry passengers on rent, went out of home with his motorbike on Wednesday night and went missing, said police.

The body was sent to Sherpur General Hospital morgue for autopsy, said OC Fashiur Rahman of Nalitabari Police Station.

During primary interrogation, the arrestees confessed that they strangled Rokon, took away his motorbike and dumped the body in the area, he said.
