Govt Pry School Teachers Welfare Trust revived

Government Primary School Teachers Welfare Trust, formed in 1985 for the wellbeing of teachers and their dependants, has been revived, reports UNB

Inducted in the newly formed 17-member trusty board are seven government representatives and 10 teachers' representatives. The DG of Primary Education Directorate will be ex-officio chairman of the committee of a two-year term.

The first meeting of the reconstituted trusty board was held at Primary and Mass Education Directorate on Tuesday with its Director General Prof Sharif Ullah in chair.

Prof Jahanara Begum, Primary and Mass Education adviser to Prime Minister, attended the meeting as chief guest.

Concerned secretary Prof (Dr) Tahmina Hossain and president of primary teachers association Prof Abul Kalam Azad were also present, among others.

The meeting elaborately discussed aims and objectives of the board, fund raising, income and expenditure and other issues. "Taking teachers' and their dependants' welfare in consideration, the meeting also took important decisions," said an official announcement.
