Teacher shortage in Shariatpur Govt College

SHARIATPUR, Sept 17.—The Shariatpur Government College is beset with manifold problems including shortage of teachers, accommodation, lack of educational atmosphere and hostels for students.

The college established in 1978 at Dhanuka, half kilometre away from district town has been nationalised in 1980.

The honours courses have been introduced in Political Science and Management from the 1998-1999 session.

The principal of the college told The Bangladesh Observer that out of 44 posts of teacher, 17 posts including assistant professors and lecturers are lying vacant for a long time, hampering the education of the students. There is no demonstrator in science class.

The principal said that reminders have been given on several occasions to the authority concerned but nothing has been done as yet in this regard.

There is no residential accommodation for the teachers.
