



PSC to hold BCS exam each year

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has decided to hold its examinations every year starting from the 25th BCS examinations reports BSS.

The decision was mentioned in the PSC annual report 2001 placed in the House on June 4.

The decision has been taken in view of session jams that prolong the academic life of students. Examination in each year would enable them to appear in it more than once.

A seven-member committee was formed in 1999 to come up with necessary recommendations to this end. The committee suggested a 13-point recommendations to address the situation.

Other recommendations of the committee included finalization of the BCS examinations schedule in consideration of SSC, HSC and degree and honours examinations of the National University.

The committee also suggested giving the examinees admission card soon after they submit ap-
