- One copy application in plain paper as per the undermentioned proforma in English should be submitted. Candidate's certificate on passing all examinations & marks sheets and pass port size photograph attested by 1<sup>st</sup> class Gazetted Officer should be enclosed with the application.

- List of the primarily selected candidates for nomination shall be hung at the Ministry of Education & Gate No. 1 of the secretariat and form will be distributed among the selected candidates immediately. No letter will be issued to the candidates. Candidate will be selected on the basis of marks secured in SSC & HSC examinations. Genuineness of candidate's papers will be verified.
- Decision of the authority will be treated as final in matters of selection of candidates.
