



HSC examinee gets 2-yr RI for threatening to kill invigilator

BRAHMANBARIA, June 20:-

A summary trial court here has sentenced an HSC examinee to two years rigorous imprisonment for threatening to kill an invigilator, reports UNB.

Court sources said the HSC examinee, Rafiq Khaz, threatened to kill the invigilator as he prevented him from copying in the HSC examination at Akhaura Railway Colony High School centre on May 19.

Later, the invigilator filed a case under the Summary Trial Act and the court after examining the witnesses pronounced the verdict Wednesday.
