

EWU orientation for freshers held

Orientation programme for the newly admitted 467 students in Summer 2003 in graduate and undergraduate programme of East West University were held on 28 and 29 May at the university, says a press release.

The orientation programme for the undergraduate programme was held on 29 May. A total of 382 students were admitted in this semester in Business Administration, Pharmacy, Computer Science, Computer Science and Engineering, Communication and Information Technology and English. It may be mentioned here that EWU recently launched its Pharmacy Department. The programme was addressed by Dr. Ferhat Anwar, Pro Vice Chancellor, Mrs. Firdaus Ali, Register and Professor Abdul Mannan, Dean of Faculties.

Mrs. Firdaus Ali, Register, welcomed the students and briefed them about the rules and regulations of the university. She also informed them about university policy and asked them to abide by EWU's code of conduct.

Dean of Faculties Professor Abdul Mannan briefed the students about the academic policy of EWU. The Dean of Faculties advised the students to be attentive and regular in their studies and avail themselves of the facilities the university is providing. He particularly mentioned university's own VSAT system and the library.

Pro Vice Chancellor Dr. Ferhat Anwar who is also the acting Vice Chancellor of the university congratulated the freshers and welcomed them to East West University. In this regard, he pointed out that EWU has the largest number of full-time faculty members.

Among others, Department Chairs and faculty were also present.

Earlier on 28 May the orientation programme for the MBA and EMBA programme of EWU was held on the campus where a total of 85 newly admitted students attended.
