

## Shibir activists stage sit-in in front of CU VC office

CHITTAGONG, Feb 26:—Supporters of Chittagong University (CU) unit Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) staged a sit-in demonstration in front of the office of Vice-Chancellor this morning.

The sit-in demonstration was organized in support of their 3-point demands. The demands were included neutral investigation of the incident of 2<sup>nd</sup> February, trial of the incident of 3<sup>rd</sup> February and removal of the syndicate decision that was taken on 384<sup>th</sup> meeting.

The workers and leaders led by CU unit of ICS President Didarul Alam Majumder and General Secretary Zahed Hossain Bhuiyan staged the demonstration at around 1:30 p.m. and submitted a memorandum to the VC.

In the memorandum the ICS demanded immediate fulfillment of their demands.

On February 2, Shahed, a student of Finance 2<sup>nd</sup> year, fell in the prey of ICS activists while he was returning from the central library of the university at about 7 p.m.

And on February 3, as many as 23 Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) workers and seven cops suffered major wounds when angry JCD workers fought pitch battle with the cops while they were going to the VC office to press home their protest over February 2 incident.
