BCL protests DU budget

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) staged demonstration on the Dhaka University campus on Tuesday protesting the University's proposed budget.

Terming the budget as anti-student the BCL demanded allocation of more money in the education and student affairs sectors in the university budget.

The DU Treasurer on Monday placed the budget amounting to Taka 94 core 77 lakh with a deficit of Taka 7 core and 77 lakh to the university's Senate.

Addressing the rally at the foot of Aporajeyo Bangla the BCL leaders criticised the university authorities for allocating the lion's share of budget, which is 61 per cent of the total amount for salary, pension and others expenditures of teachers, staff and officials of the university.

Presided over by BCL DU unit President Delwar Hossain, the rally was addressed by its central President Liakat Sikder, Vice-President Marufa Akhter Popy, Rafiqul Islam and Joint Secretary Saifuzzaman Shikhor.
