

Attack on former DU VC slated

Different teachers, students and political organisations have condemned and protested against the attack on former vice chancellor of Dhaka University and two other teachers by armed cadres on the university campus, on Sunday night.

In separate statements on Monday, leaders of the organisations said that the attack on the university teachers proved the poor law and order situation existing in the country.

Some 150 teachers of Dhaka University in a statement urged the government to ensure security to the citizens.

Awami League-backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), Ganatantrik Oikya Parishad, Federation of NGOs in Bangladesh, and Swadhinata Chukitsak Parishad, also condemned the incident.

Dhaka University authority formed a five-member committee to investigate the incident in which two miscreants allegedly opened fire on three senior teachers—Prof AK Azad Chowdhury, Prof Durga Das and Prof Sultana Shafi - when they came out of the Business Faculty at about 8 pm on Sunday night.
