## Cancellation of new system in PSC exam demanded

General Student Unity of Dhaka University urged the government to accept their six-point demands including cancellation of the new criteria of Public Service Commission (PSC).

The demands include: cancellation of the quota system and the 200 marks viva and 300 marks optional written examination in the Bangladesh Civil Service (BCS) examination.

In a recent move the PSC has set a new criteria of having at least 45 per cent marks in English and Bengali separately for the candidates who are willing to appear in the future BCS examination.

Speaking at the press conference the students vowed to go for tough action programme against if their demands are not met within this week.

The students will launch a signature campaign and form a human chain today (Monday) and stage demonstration in the campus on Wednesday in support of their demands.
