

JCD ultimatum to DU teacher to resign

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on Saturday gave an ultimatum of seven days to Prof. Shafiqur Rahman of Law Department to quit his post.

Addressing a rally at Battola the JCD leaders warned that if he fails to resign from his post during this time the JCD activists along with the general students will force him to quit.

"It is not conceivable that a teacher of Dhaka University can make such indecent remarks on an elected Prime Minister, but Prof. Shafique is the man who has done this. So he has no right to retain the distinguished post" said Shahabuddin Lahu, President of the JCD central committee while addressing a rally at Battola of the university.

The JCD demanded immediate removal of Shafiqur Rahman from the university.

Presided over by JCD DU unit President Amirul Islam Alim, the rally was addressed by Vice President, Sultan Salauddin Tuku, Shafiul Bari Babu, Golam Nahin, Joyonto Kunda. Following the rally the JCD brought out a procession on the campus.

However, Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) staged demonstration on the campus protesting the firing incident at the residence of Prof. Shafiqur Rahman.

Accusing JCD activists the BCL leaders demanded immediate arrest and punishment of culprits who opened fire at Prof. Shafique's residence last week.
