

## Cancellation of night shift in DU demanded

Progotishil Chhatra Jote (PCJ), a platform of eight left leaning student groups formed a human chain on Dhaka University campus on Saturday protesting the decision of introducing evening shift in Social Welfare and Research Institute.

Scores of leaders and activists of PCJ joined the human chain to press home their demands for cancellation of evening courses on commercial basis.

Following the human chain the PCJ brought out a procession on the campus and staged a rally in front of Arts Building.

Addressing the rally the PCJ leaders vowed to go for tougher action program if the university authorities would not change the decision of introducing evening shift in Social Welfare Institute and Library and Information Science Department.

Among others, President of Shamajtantrik Chhatra Front Khalekuzaman Lipton, President of Bangladesh Chhatra Union Lula Nur, President of Bangladesh Chhatra Federation Taslima Akhter were present at the human chain program.

The PCJ will stage demonstration on the campus today (Sunday) and organise a roundtable meeting at TSC Seminar room on May 16 in support of its demands.
