DU situation tense as 3 more explosives found

Tense situation has been prevailing on Dhaka University campus following Friday's incidents of terrorist activities at the teachers' residence.

Police recovered another three live explosives near the residence of Prof. Shafiqur Rahman of Law Department of the university on Saturday morning.

Additional police forces were deployed on the campus, especially at Vice-Chancellor's residence to avoid any untoward incidents.

It may be recalled that six live bombs were recovered from the residence of VC of Dhaka University on Friday night.

On the same night the residence of Prof. Shafiqur Rahman of Law Department was allegedly attacked by a group of armed activists. Some unidentified youths numbering five to seven persons opened four to five rounds of shots at Shahidullah Hall residence of the teacher. None of his family member was injured in the firing incidents.

Prof. Shafique alleged that the activists of ruling party backed Jatiyatabadi Chharta Dal (JCD) were involved in the terrorist activities.

He also filed a case with Ramna Thana against Shafayet Hossain Sabuz, an MA-student of Law Department, Abdul Alim, a 4th year student of the department and Md. Ali Imran, a 2nd year student of the department and President of Law Department unit of JCD in his connection on Friday night.

Police forces had been de-

ployed at the residence of Prof. Shafiqur Rahman on Friday night. Vice-Chancellor of the university Prof. SMA Faiz, Provost of Shahidullah Hall, Prof. Abul Khair and Proctor Atiqur Rahman visited the residence of Shafiqur Rahman on Friday night.

Proctor of the university told The Bangladesh Observer on Saturday that identified quarters are trying to create anarchy on the campus. He also vowed that stern action will be taken against the convict of the terrorists activists.

A few days ago police recovered several bombs in front of the residence of Prof. Rashidul Hasan, Treasurer of the university. Moreover in last months two explosives were exploded in front of VC's house.

Awami League backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) however staged a rally in front of DUCSU Building protesting the Friday's incident.

Addressing the rally the BCL accused JCD activists for the firing at the residence of Shafiqur Rahman and demanded arrest and punishment of the culprits. Presided over by DU unit BCL Vice-President Shahadat Hossain Shabuz the rally was addressed among others by Vice-President Rafiqul Islam, General Secretary Hemaet Hossain Himu, Vice-President Abu Zafar, Joint Secretary Rafikul Alam Gaffari Rasel, Organising Secretary Abu Sayid, and Secretary of Suryasen Hall unit BCL Abu Hanif. Following the rally the BCL brought out a procession on the campus.
