

## DU Senate polls from May 22

The much talked about Senate election of Dhaka University will be held on May 22 and 27 in 34 centres outside Dhaka and June 2 in Dhaka.

Graduates from Dhaka University will elect 25 registered graduates as the members of the senate.

Two panels will contest the election. One Pro-Liberation "Gonotrik Oikyo Parishad (GOP)" and another pro-BNP and Jamate-e-Islami, backed forum.

GOP on Wednesday at a press conference at Dhaka Reporters Unity auditorium announced its 25 member's panel for the senate election.

The GOP swept to the senate election in 1995 and 1999.

In the press conference the GOP announced its seven point election pledges including re-implementation of Dhaka University Ordinance 1973, appointment of Vice-Chancellor through senate election, and free the campus from session jam and terrorism.

The candidates from GOP are: Former Director General of National Museum AKM Shamsuzzaman Khan, former VP of DUCSU and former member of the Parliament AKM Huzzaman, Editor of the Bangladesh Observer and President of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury, Prof. Anwar Hossain, Aroma Dutta, Asit Boron Saha, Kazi Akram Uddin Ahmed, Dr M Akhteruzzaman, Dr M Iqbal, Mahub Uddin Ahmed, Mahfuza Khanom, Abdus Samad Talukder, Md. Afzal Hossain, Azizur Rahman, Golam Quddus, Habibur Rahman Khan, Shamsul Haque Bhuiyan, Abdul Bari, Md. Ozaer Faruk, Monjur Kader, Nilufer Begum, Sayed Ahmed, Subrata Chowdhury and Shamoli Dev.
