## DU social welfare students oppose evening shift

Students of Social Welfare Institute of Dhaka University yesterday protested the move to introduce MSS evening course at the institute.

They submitted a memorandum to Vice-Chancellor Prof. SMA Faiz demanding cancellation of the evening course which, they said, will be run on commercial basis.

Students of evening shift will have to pay higher fees and this will create discrimination among the students of the institute, they said in the memorandum.

They also took out a protest procession and held a rally on the campus.

Institute Director Prof. Md. Abu Taher said a five-member committee was formed at an academic council meeting yesterday to discuss with the agitating students.
