

Call to elect JOP candidates in DU senate election

Speakers at a panel orientation ceremony on Saturday appealed to voters to elect Jatiyatabadi Okiya Parishad (JOP) candidates in Dhaka University senate election to restore the glorious image of the university and ensure a congenial academic atmosphere, reports BSS.

They made the appeal at the panel orientation programme of JOP at the TSC auditorium on Saturday afternoon with former chief election commissioner Justice Abdur Rouf in the chair.
