

## Demand to appoint VC from Profs of SBAU

Sher-e-Bangla Agriculture University Teachers' Association on Sunday demanded to the government for making appointment to Vice-chancellor (VC) post of the university from the professors of the same university.

To press home their demand, the teachers, students and employees of the university will make a 'human chain' at the university campus today (Monday) at 11:00am.

The association threatened that the teachers, students and employees of the university, combinedly resist any attempt to appoint the VC from other university.

A press release signed by the President and General Secretary of the association said that a total of 10 out of 130 teachers have at the university as Professors. Of them, most of the Professors submitted their applications for the lofty post in response to the advertisement by the Ministry of Education. It however said that the professors are unevaluated during the appointment of VC in last two tenures.

The release mentioned that the government on March 2 had removed the VC of the university on charge of corruption.

It may be noted that, four professors of Bangladesh Agriculture University (BAU) were appointed VC in four universities and another is member of the Public Service Commission (PSC). But a widespread allegation of corruption and irregularities was brought against them.
