

## KU takes initiative to develop edn standard

KHULNA, May 24:—Khulna University authorities have recently taken up some initiatives to develop its educational standard and congenial atmosphere and to make the administrative activities transparent and accountable, reports UNB.

The university started its educational activities in 1991-92 academic session. Some 4,287 students are studying in the university under 16 disciplines at present.

As part of the new measures, the university is going to introduce Masters and Ph.D. in new four disciplines.

The university has also launched internet backbone network and established its own server and digital telephone exchange of 500 lines and new ad-

ministrative building and upgraded the female dormitory to two-storied building.

Construction works of central library and 3<sup>rd</sup> academic building are also progressing fast.

When contacted, Vice Chancellor Dr M Salfuddin, appointed by the government on February 28 this year, said the authorities have also taken some positive initiatives considering the social status of the innocent officials and employees of the university to bring

the congenial atmosphere in the university administration.

It is to mention that Education Ministry suspended all new appointments in the university on November 29, 2007 on charge of various irregularities and corruption.
