The election was scheduled for tomorrow and all preparations were completed, sources said.

The chief commissioner of the election Prof Azizur Rahman said they received a letter from the Chittagong Superintendent of Police (SP) yesterday morning and it directed them to seek permission from the district administration for holding the election.

"We met SP Kamrul Ahsan in the evening [yesterday] and he asked us to obtain the permission from Chittagong DC [deputy commissioner]," Azizur Rahman said.

"We would meet the DC soon and issue a notification today [Monday] postponing the election," he said.
