

**Hons admission
23 candidates
to vie for
each DU seat

About 23 candidates will vie for each seat in the upcoming admission tests for the first year honours courses of Dhaka University (DU) for 2008-2009 academic session scheduled to be held from November 14 to December 1.

A total of 1,27,171 forms have been submitted against 5,560 seats in 10 faculties and institutes in the university which means 23 candidates will vie for each seat.

Of them, 32,454 forms have been submitted against 1,229 seats in 'Ka' unit that means 27 students will vie for each seat. A total of 28,260 forms against 2,627 seats in 'Kha' unit, 25,850 forms against 880 seats in 'Ga' unit and 40,607 forms have been submitted against 760 seats in 'Gha' unit that means 11.29 and 53 students will vie for each seat respectively.

The DU authorities have earned a total of Taka 3.81 crore by selling admission forms. Sales and submission of admission forms ended on Monday. Each of the application form was collected at a cost of Taka 300.

The admission tests of 'Ga' unit (business studies faculty) will be held on November 14. 'Ka' unit (science faculty) on November 21. 'Gha' unit (combined unit) on November 28 and the admission test of 'Kha' unit (arts and social science faculty) will be held on December 1.
