

DU, JCD, BCL SCF units hold separate rallies

Demanding immediate release of former Prime Minister and BNP chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia and all leaders and activists, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), the student front of BNP, on Tuesday observed a daylong strike programme across the country. To press home their demand, they will submit a memorandum to the Chief Adviser tomorrow (Thursday).

The JCD also called for sending Zia's two sons - Tarique Rahman and Arafat Rahman Koko - abroad for better treatment, without further delay. They also demanded

release of JCD president Azizul Bari Helal.

Leaders and activities led by JCD acting president Sultan Salaud-din Tuku observed the programme at the foot of Aparajeya Bangla from 9.00 am to 6.00 pm.

They demanded release of all political detainees of the party and withdrawal of all cases filed against them. JCD general secretary Shafiq Bari Babu, Nurul Islam Noyon, Joyonta Kumar Kundu, Mostafa Khan Safari and Abdul Kader Bhuiyan Jewel were present at the programme.

Sultan Salaud-din Tuku said the

present caretaker government has no right to give transit to India. He also said the student politics should not be baned through enactment of new law.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the students' wing of Awami League (AL), on Tuesday demonstrated and brought out a rally on the DU campus in protest against assaulting a freedom fighter by Jammat created 'Jatiya Muktiyoddha Parishad'. The agitating BCL activists also burnt the effigy of Jamaat-Islami Ameer Matiur Rahman Nizami.
