

Holding of DUCSU polls demanded

Samajtantrik Chhatra Front (SCF), a left leaning student organisation, demanded the Dhaka University administration that implementation of their several point of demands including immediate construction of the proposed underpass or foot over-bridges at Shahbagh Intersection.

Sticking to their seven-point demands, the SCF leaders on Saturday submitted a memorandum to the DU Vice-chancellor at his office and urged the authorities to

take effective steps to overcome the present crisis of the university.

They demanded the university's 'Paribesh Parishad' active and also they voiced for holding the election to the Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU) immediately. They also demanded the cancellation of the proposed 'Umbrella Act' as it would cripple the public university autonomy.

In the memorandum signed by the president and general secre-

tary of SCF said 12 persons including eight students of DU were killed in road mishap at Shahbagh crossing in last 10 years. The foot-over bridge is the long cherished desire of the students of DU for crossing the roads at Shahbagh intersection.

The SCF demanded increasing the number of seats and photocopy machine and introduce of computerised catalog system and adequate Internet facility for the students at the central library of the university.

They demanded withdrawal of the newly imposed semester and Department development fee. They also demanded the cancellation of all kinds of commercial courses. They asked for the removal of newly built TV screen at Shahbagh and all kinds of commercial billboard from the campus.

The SCF leaders also demanded increasing the allocation in the education and research sector and give a subsidy at the dining and canteen of the dormitory. Construction of new Hall to reduce the accommodation crisis and purchasing of new bus are also the parts to their set of demands.
