

VC admits unrest on Campus Feed with fuel of a section of teachers in KUET

KHULNA, May 13: The reason behind the Sunday's clash of two rival students group were to feed with fuel of a section of Teachers of KUET. A section of teachers were responsible regarding the Sunday's clash when investigating by this Correspondent while visiting the spot.

It may be noted here that all classes of KUET were suspended till 31 May and dormitories were asked to vacate by the order of the authorities on Monday apprehending violence to the campus. It was learnt that two student of second and 4th year of KUET were engaged in quarrel of following a trifling matter during the 'Nabin Baron' at the campus on April 28. A clash was occurred between Shukul Das, a second year student of mechanical Engineering and Alamgir, a 4th year student of EEC discipline following the Sunday's incident.

Tension was prevailing at the campus among the students. Teachers were divided into groups, although the situation has been taken under control by the authorities after forming seven members probe committee. Two rival groups made processing of students for and against Aftab Ahmed, director of students welfare association of Amar Ekushey dormitory clashed each other. Some students of KUET informed having supremacy of the Teachers of Mechanical Engineering discipline and they support the students of mentioning discipline

with electrical demanded for reducing power of the teachers who are in the top position in the administration of KUET. The teacher association called a meeting discussing the event but it was ended without taking any decision. Head of the civil engineering discipline and also the chief of the probe committee prof. Dr. M.A. Bashar informed this Correspondent that the next meeting will be held soon and then it will be selected our next master plan. Because of closing of the University and absence of students probing will be hampered, opening KUET the real occurrences will come to light, said one of the members of probe committee.

The vice Chancellor of KUET prof. Dr. Nowsher Ali admitted that a group of vested interests is trying out and out to vitiate peaceful academic atmosphere. Vice chancellor said after holding a meeting of Teachers Council of KUET on Monday. The meeting was presided over by VC; the meeting was attended by heads of all disciplines and provosts of all dormitories. It was resolved in the meeting that steps would be taken to remove credibility gap between teachers and students.
