ADMISSION TESTS

36532 to vie for 7479 seats in 24 govt schools

A total of 36,532 students will vie for the 7,479 seats in the admission tests in city's 24 government schools.

The admission tests will be held on January 16, 18 and 20 while the results will be published on January 25.

"Admission tests for class one to four will be held at 10:00am and for class five to nine at 2:00 pm. We have already divided the government schools in three groups - A, B and C. Admission tests for the schools in Group A will be held on January 16, Group B on January 18

and Group C on January 20," said Sirajum Munira, deputy director of Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education (DSHE).

A total of 12,487 children will vie for 1,379 seats in class one, 3,029 for 460 seats in class two, 4,322 for 1,049 seats in class three, 2,880 for 694 seats in class four, 5,219 for 375 seats in class five, 7,237 for 1,813 seats in class six, 1,475 for 501 seats in class seven, 1,628 for 496 seats in class eight and 2165 for 692 seats in class nine, sources in DSHE said.

A meeting headed by DSHE Director General Prof KM Aorangajeb yesterday decided to take some measurers for holding

the admission test and post activities properly.

Schools in Group A are Govt Laboratory High School, New Govt Girls' High School, Mirpur Govt High School, Islamia Govt High School, Motijheel Govt High School, Khilgaon Govt High School, Mohammadpur Govt High School and Nawabpur Govt High School.

Motijheel Govt Boys' High School, Narinda Govt High School and Dhanmondi Govt Girls' High School are in Group B while Dhaka Collegiate School, Tejgaon Govt Girls' High School and Armanitola Govt High School are in Group C.
