

## Closed-door meet in progress

# Tense mount on CU campus over probable clash

CHITTAGONG, Jun 6:—Tense gripped Chittagong University campus today over possible confrontation between the workers and supporters of the Jamaat backed Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) and Awami League backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL).

Chhatra League started building up its strength on the campus in terms of man and machine to push out the Islami Chhatra Shibir men from the university's dorms after overwhelming victory of its parent organization in the December 29 general elections.

Panic mounted among the ordinary students when the ICS men started marching on the campus chanting provocative slogans against the BCL workers and possibility of retaliatory actions were speculated at about 11:00 a.m.

The security people on the campus foiled a move of the BCL men for encounter by chasing them out. However, the ICS men at this stage dispersed fearing police action.

The BCL men turned about on Dhaka and Rajshahi university campuses after the landside vic-

tory of the Awami League led mega alliance while the ICS men ran away from their dorms and dens.

The ICS here on the CU campus has still retained its supremacy and command on the dorms with the support of the highly politicized administration.

Secretary of the CU unit of the BCL Earsad Hossain claimed that they always had been in favor of

congenial atmosphere on the campus but the ICS was out to spoil the environment of the campus.

Sources said that innocent students had been quitting their dorms fearing confrontation and bloodshed.

The university's high ups joined a closed-door meeting with the vice-chancellor of the university in the chair to protect the congenial atmosphere on the campus. The meeting had been in progress till the time of dispatching this report.
