

NU degree exams begin today

Degree pass, subsidiary and certificate course examinations-2008 under the National University will begin across the country today (Tuesday), reports BSS.

Controller of the examinations of the National University said a total of 2,51,376 students from 1,412 colleges would appear in the examination to be held in three phases for first, second and third year.

The first year examination will begin today (Tuesday), to be followed by the second year examination on June 6. The third year (final year) examination will begin on June 18, he added.

A total of 543 centres were set up across the country to hold the examination while a control room has been set up at the National University to conduct the examinations smoothly.

A total of 90,008 students will appear in first year examination, 72,004 for the second year and 88,350 students for final year. Besides, 612 students will sit for certificate course and 400 students for subsidiary subjects.
