

4 JCD men hurt in BCL attack at Sylhet Agri Univ.

AT LEAST four Sylhet Agricultural University unit Chhatra Dal activists, including the unit's member secretary, were injured as Chhatra League activists attacked them on the campus early Wednesday.

Of the injured, Sanjay, Raghunath and Piyas were

admitted to Sylhet Osmani Medical College with serious injuries. The university unit Chhatra Dal's member secretary Abdullah Al Sayeed, who was also injured, was given primary treatment, physicians said.

Campus sources said Chhatra League activists, armed up with hockey sticks, iron rods and bamboo sticks, attacked Chhatra Dal activists about 2:15am when they were watching

match between Spain and Paraguay on television at the New Student Hall.

Most of the Chhatra Dal activists present there managed to get away as the Chhatra League launched the attack, campus sources said.

Rokanuzzaman Bappi, joint convener of the university unit Chhatra Dal, said the Chhatra League activists launched the attack without any provocation. At least four were injured.

'We sent the injured to hospital in the morning as

no one from the university authorities came forward with help despite repeated contacts,' Bappi said.

The New Student Hall provost, Snehangsu Shekhar Chanda, in the afternoon said the injured students were sent to hospital early morning after they had received the news.

'Steps have been taken for their proper treatment and the university authorities have already been informed of the matter,' the provost said.
