

## CUET teachers want early appointment of vice-chancellor

THE Chittagong University of Engineering and Technology Teachers' Association on Wednesday demanded immediate appointment of a vice-chancellor on the vacant post.

The association raised the demand after several hundred CUET students went on demonstrations few days earlier to push for the same demand.

CUETTA leaders placed the demand at a press conference in the West Gallery of CUET on Wednesday.

Computer engineering chairman Muhammad Ibrahim Khan presided over the press conference while engineering and technology dean Ashutosh Saha, professors Abdur Rashid and Abdur Rahman Bhuiyan were also present.

CUETTA general secretary Mir Muhammad Saki Kawsar read out a written speech at the press conference.

The teachers said that they demanded vice-chancellor on the basis of seniority, honesty and a person with an excellent engineering background and expertise.
