

Four injured in BCL factional clash at CU

FOUR Chhatra League activists were injured in a factional clash on the Chittagong University campus on Saturday.

The police held five BCL men from the spot in this connection.

The injured are Md Roni, mathematics 2nd year, Rabiul Alam Rabi, anthropology 3rd year and CU joint-secretary of BCL, Jahedul Islam, physics 2nd year, and Hossain, sociology 3rd year.

Critically injured Jahed and

Hossain were sent to Chittagong Medical College Hospital.

Police and witnesses said Rakib, history 3rd year student and a member of university shuttle train-based group called Sixty-Nine, led by CU unit BCL organising secretary Alamgir Tipu, picked an altercation with Shuvo, a member of Varsity Express group, loyal to CU BCL president Mamun, over a trivial matter at the CU railway station around 2:30pm.

At one point, they started scuffling with each other. Later, Sixty-Nine group

men, equipped with sharp weapons and led by Alamgir Tipu, attacked the VX men, leaving the five injured.

Rafiqul Islam, sub-inspector of CU police outpost, told journalists that they had held five BCL activists from the spot during the clash and added that extra police forces had been deployed on the campus.

CU unit BCL vice-president Rajib, loyal to the Mamun group, filed a case with the Hathazari police against 13 unnamed people in connection with the incident.
