

## BCL faction demands arrest of rivals at CU

A GROUP of leaders and activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League brought out a procession at Chittagong University on Monday, demanding immediate arrest of their rival BCL activists who attacked them.

They also gave a 48-hour ultimatum to the university authorities, to arrest the accused and their expulsion from the university.

Witnesses said the BCL activists, loyal to BCL president Mamun group, brought out a procession from the Shah Amanat Hall.

Informed policemen and proctorial body members rushed to the spot and calmed the agitate BCL workers.

Later, the leaders gave the ultimatum to the authorities, demanding immediate arrest of the attackers.

They also demanded expulsion of BCL leaders and workers including Alamgir Tipu, organising secretary, Md Nazmul, Jamir uddin, cultural secretary, Mansur Uddin and Abu kawsar Roni, finance secretary, of CU unit BCL.

Following a factional clash between two BCL groups on September 29, the authorities formed a four-member probe committee, headed by professor Khan Tawhid Osman, dean of biological science faculty and also student welfare advisor of CU.
