

Eden students demand principal's resignation

THE students of Eden Girls College have demanded resignation of its principal Roushanara Begum.

They came up with the demand from a human chain programme in front of the college on Thursday.

A large number of students took part in the half an hour programme from 12:30pm.

They also demanded their accommodation in the college until their Master's examinations are completed and punishment of those responsible for attacking them during Wednesday's protest.

Earlier, on Wednesday,

some students confined over 20 teachers, including the principal, in the administrative building for over 15 hours demanding an end to the accommodation problem in the dormitory of the college.

Four students were injured in an attack by the dormitory staff and others when the agitators were coming out of the administrative building around 10:00pm on Wednesday after releasing the teachers as they agreed to resolve the accommodation problem.

Protesting at the attack, the agitators again confined the teachers in the building.

The police rescued the teachers at about 1:30am on Thursday.
