

'Missing' DU teacher found in Khagrachhari

THE Dhaka University teacher, Nur Uddin Alo, believed to have been kidnapped on Tuesday, was found at Khagrachhari on Wednesday.

According to the police, the political science lecturer turned up at Dighinala police station in the hill district about 1:30pm and fainted moments later.

'We identified him as the missing Dhaka University teacher Nur Uddin by the identity card found on him,' said officer-in-charge Shahadat Hossain.

The police officer said the teacher was taken to the

Upazila health complex.

Later, the teacher was sent to the government hospital in Khagrachhari town for better treatment, said a doctor of the health complex, Shubal Jyoti Chakma.

A student of the department, Enamul Haque, filed a general diary with the Shahbagh police on Tuesday evening claiming that the teacher had been abducted.

Enamul said he decided to file the GD after receiving an SMS from the teacher stating that he had been kidnapped.

University proctor Amzad Ali told the news agency after the GD was filed that a student had informed them about the kidnapping.
