

JU student attacked near campus

A JAHANGIRNAGAR University student became critically injured as some unnamed people attacked him near the campus on Sunday night.

Najmus Sakib Anik, a second-year student of chemistry who is also joint convener of Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal of the Shaheed Rafiq-Jabbar Hall unit, became injured as the attackers beat him with pipes, iron rods and bricks at Islamnagar market near the campus.

Some of his friends later rescued him and sent him to the university medical centre for primary treatment.

Birendra Kumar Biswas, a physician at the medical

centre, said that he was in a critical condition because of his injury in the head.

He was later sent to Dhaka Medical Centre at the advice of physicians of Enam Medical Centre at Savar.

Campus sources said that Anik had picked up a quarrel with Atikur Rahman, a master's student which might have led to the attack.

Zakirul Islam, president of the university unit Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, said that the attack had proved that the university was free of crimes. He urged an impartial investigation of the incident.

The proctor, Tapan Kumar Shaha, said, 'We have heard of the incident. Authorities will take steps for his treatment.'
