

NU students rally for steps to cut session jam

THE National University students in Sylhet on Tuesday afternoon formed a human chain to press their demands including clearing off the existing session jam.

Graduation and post-graduation students from different public and private colleges under the banner of National Uni-

versity Movement Forum, Sylhet participated in the human chain in the afternoon in front of the Central Shaheed Minar in the city.

The demands included opening of sub-offices of the university in the country's divisional headquarters, launching academic calendar, addressing the crisis of teacher, classroom, dormitory and trans-

portation.

The student forum leaders in a rally during the human chain also threatened of launching a tougher movement across the country, if the authorities concerned failed to bring an atmosphere in the educational institution campuses through meeting the demands without wasting anymore time.
