

## Edn ministry finalises talent hunt policy

EDUCATION ministry on Wednesday finalised 'Creative Talent Hunt Policy 2012' to search talents and give awards among secondary and higher secondary students.

From now on, every year 12 students will be given special awards nationally after competition at upazila, district and divisional levels.

Students from VI to XII can participate in the com-

petition which will be on four subjects: Language and Literature (both Bangla and English), Science (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology), Mathematics and Computer and Bangladesh Studies.

The competition will take place at the beginning of every year.

In language and literature, the competition pattern will be on essay writing, impromptu speech and story telling, in Science, MCQ question-answer, Sci-

ence related article writing and project presentations, in Mathematics, written and verbal Mathematics solution, computer problem solution, in Bangladesh studies, written and verbal MCQ tests.

The policy was finalised at a meeting on Wednesday at the Education Ministry auditorium in the secretariat.

Presided over by education minister Nurul Islam Nahid, among others, Dhaka University professor emeritus Anisuzzaman, noted artist Mustafa Monwar, Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor Professor AASM Arefin Siddique and education secretary Kamal Abdul Naser Chowdhury attended the meeting.
