# 22 teachers of seven Lalmonirhat pry schools transferred

Twenty-two teachers of seven government primary schools in Hajibandha upazila have been transferred as the schools' results in the terminal examinations of 2011 were very poor.

As per directive of State Minister for Primary and Mass Education Motahar Hossain, Lalmonirhat District Primary Education Officer Nobez Uddin Sarker issued the transfer orders on Wednesday last.

The education officer said transfer is a punishment for the teachers. Earlier, show cause notices were issued to the teachers, but they could not give satisfactory replies, he added.

They will face departmental action if they do not join new workplaces, the education officer said.
