# Admission tests in city schools begin Friday

ADMISSION tests in city schools began on Friday, with

Students will be admitted in Class I through lottery, and in VI and Class IX based on their results in Primary Completion Exam and Junior High School Certificate examination respectively.

The admission tests for Government Laboratory School, Tajgaon Government High School, Khajgaon Government High School, Khajgaon Government High School, Navabpur Government High School, Dharmon-nagar Government Girls High School, Sher-e-Bangla College School, Dhaka College-High School, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Government Girls High School, Ganabhaban High School, and Mirpur Government High School will be held on December 14, 15 and 17, while the lottery for admission in Class I in those schools would be drawn on December 27.

The admission tests for Boys High School, Armani-High School, Tikauli Kannin-School, Tikauli Kannin-School, Tejgaon Government Boys High School, Dhaka College-High School, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Government Girls High School, and Mirpur Government High School and College principal Farhad Hossain said that they would make a decision on December 15 about the tests for admission in different classes and lottery for Class I admissions.

Raushan Ara, an admission seeker's guardian, said she was worried about enrolling her daughter at a 'quality' school due to quota system and admission process. Abu Toab Khan, another guardian, said that trade-off huge about usually look place in city school admissions in every year.

Nine per cent students will be enrolled in the city schools in three quotas, as there are now a 5 per cent quota for freedom fighters' children and grandchildren and a 2 per cent quota for all non-government schools. Moreover, non-government schools in the capital reserve 2 per cent of their seats for the children of education ministry officials.

According to the admission guideline set by the government, the tests will be held for the admission in Class II, III, IV, V, VII, and VIII.

Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education for Dharmon-nagar Government Girls High School, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Government Boys High School, Dharmon-nagar Government Girls High School, Navabpur Government High School, Dharmon-nagar Government Girls High School, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Government Girls High School, Dhaka College-High School, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Government Girls High School, and Mirpur Government High School will be held on December 14, 15 and 17, while the lottery for admission in Class I in those schools would be drawn on December 27.

Education officer Indu Bhushan Deb said admission in government primary schools would start on January 1. Ideal School and College principal Shahan Ara said all branches of the school would hold admission tests for class IV to VIII on December 14 and for class II and III on December 15. The lottery for admission in Class I will take place on December 17 and 18.
