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SCHOOL ADMISSION quota for DCS want 5pc govt officials

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DEPUTY Commissioners have recommended for allotting five per cent quota in government secondary school admission for the children of the government officers and employees. The cabinet division last month received the recommendations from some DCS and forwarded it to the ministry of education for its observations.

A senior official of cabinet division told New Age that the issue is expected to be discussed at the annual DCS conference scheduled for July 23. Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid would address the issue at the conference, he said.

Education ministry staff and government secondary school teachers already get a two per cent seat quota for their children while the freedom-fighters have five

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There are 317 government secondary schools in government offices. Besides, the DEO has the authority to oversee and forward the applications of newly recruited teachers and employees to the Director of Secondary and Higher Education for salary from the exchequer in the form of monthly pay order (MPO). Md. Zabunul Hoque, DC of Narail said, 'We also want inclusion of DC or his/her representative in the management committees and recruitment body at non-government schools, madrasahs and colleges. It would ensure quality and transparency.'
