

None held for Dhaka College gunfight killing

Police did not arrest anyone over early yesterday's gunfight between two factions of Bangladesh Chhatra League at Dhaka College, which left a student dead and four others injured.

The central BCL, however, suspended the college unit committee and removed its president Fuad Hasan Pallab and general secretary Sakib Hasan Swim along with five other leaders.

Meanwhile, Swim filed a murder case with New Market Police Station against 23 people, saying the loyalists of Pallab opened fire on his supporters, killing Asaduzzaman A] Faruk.

The gunfight ensued from an altercation after Swim tried to settle a complaint that Ujjal Khan, an expelled BCL activist and loyalist of Pallab, mugged a mobile phone, Swim added.

The body of Faruk, a master's student, was sent to his village home in Panchagarh.
