

Student detained for admission forgery at DU

DHAKA University authorities on Tuesday handed over one of its students to the police in connection with forgery in admission process.

A Salimullah Muslim Hall resident Abu Huraira Sajib of Islamic studies, claiming himself a nephew of Chhatra League DU unit president Mehedi Hasan Molla, took Tk 25,000 from Omar Faruk, an admission seeker of 2011-12 session, promising him admission, campus sources said.

A 2nd year student, Sajib, according to the agreement, received Tk 15,000 from Faruk, DU proctor Anzad Ali said.

Being deceived, Faruk contacted with the BCL leader Mehedi and learnt that Sajib was not a relative of the Chhatra League leader.

On Tuesday, Sajib came in front of the university central library to meet Faruk. In the meantime, BCL activists informed the proctor, who handed over Sajib to the Shahbag police station, the sources said.
