# Two cases filed against 200 JCD activists

TWO cases were filed on Friday against more than 200 Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal activists for Thursday's clash with Bangladesh Chhatra League and vandalism at Islamic University in Kushtia.

The IU police officer-in-charge, Atiar Rahman, university unit Bangladesh Chhatra League vice-president Towfiqur Rahman Hillar filed a case against 200 people, naming 57 Chhatra Dal activists, accusing them of attacking Chhatra League activists.

The university proctor, AHM Akhtaruazzaman, also filed a case against unnamed people in con-

nection with vandalism on the campus, said university registrar M Moslem Uddin.

IU police arrested eight Chhatra Dal activists, including IU unit president Omar Farique, on Thursday from campus and another one on early Friday at Vadradanga adjacent to the campus.

On Thursday, at least 30 people, including two journalists, were injured and six busses and one ambulance were vandalised in a clash between the student organisations that erupted after the ruling Awami League-backed Chhatra League attacked on a rally of the opposition BNP-backed Chhatra Dal on the campus.
